5. ORGANIZATIONAL UPDATE

Candice proceeded to provide an organizational update – stating that there have been many events that were all relatively well attended. Advising that we are always looking for student feedback on events that they would like to see at their campus.

The Health Plan changes for this year included:

- Increasing practitioner maximum coverage from \$40 to \$50 per appointment
- Increasing prescription coverage to 90% (maximum \$5,000) from 80% (maximum \$3,000)

The SAHC logo and branding will be redesigned next year as the Graphic Design Program students will be creating it as a part of their second-semester project. The plan is to launch the new branding by early September 2026.
